While the exact specifications of their cooperation are still to be worked out, the simulator technology investments, both civilian and military, means that within a few miles of each sits some of the most

advanced training technology available anywhere in the world.

"We need a lot of pilots, both in our nation and around the globe," said Major Goldsmith, and a cooperative agreement between the Cal Guard and Cypress College would be beneficial for all involved.

Actually, said Valdez, the college has been cooperating with JFTB for five years, when he initially called Airfield Manager Jeffrey Sibley to get clearance for the department's new drone program, and Sibley has since even participated by teaching and lecturing at Cypress college.
