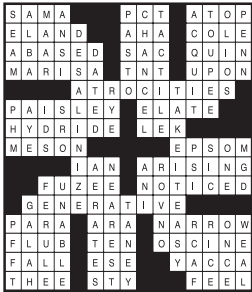

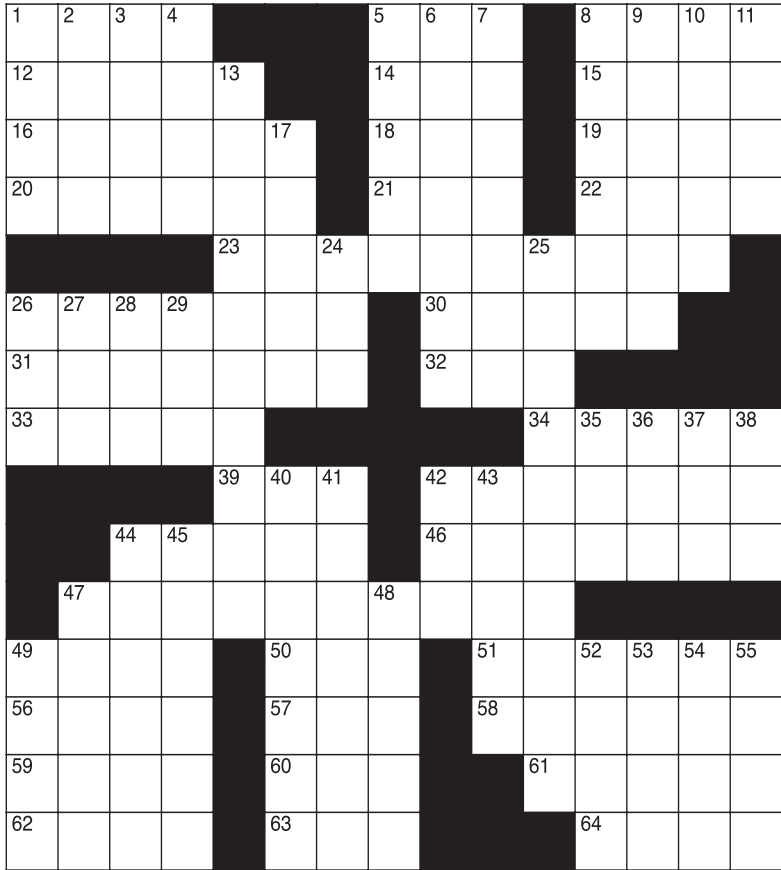

**AUTUMN, MERCURY
RETROGRADES IN LIBRA &
SUKKOT**

Sun has entered Libra, informing us
autumn has arrived in our northern
