TO BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBER, Scott Fayette : Pursuant to Section 11020, California Election Code, the undersigned registered voters of Area 4 of the Los Alamitos Unified School District, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from office of Member of the Los Alamitos Board of Education, in Los Alamitos, California, and to demand election of a successor in that office by the people and constituents of that district.

The grounds for the recall are as follows:

Multiple violations of CA Gov Code 54950, et. seq., known as the brown act of 1953. Conducting discussions and private meetings, excluding public participation and opinion prior to making decisions that affect the health, well-being, and education of our children.

Multiple counts - accessory to crimes under CA Penal Code 273a pc. willfully exposing children under the age of 18 to unjustifiable pain, suffering and potential psychological damage by forcing children to remove themselves from traditional educational and social environments against their will without documented justification.

Deprivation of liberties and due process under the 14th amendment of U.S. Constitution by implementing rules and regulations outside their authority without proper discussion and vote by elected legislators far beyond the reasonable period of time following a declared "state of emergency" which shall not exceed 60 days without a vote from legislators.

Federal violation The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act 1996 (HIPAA). Implementation of policies requiring students and volunteer parents to disclose personal medical information and treatments in contrast to Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable Health Information ("Privacy Rule")

Also, CA Civil Code 51; CA Gov Code 12926(q); CA Health and Safety Code 24171; and CA Health and Safety Code 24172.

ORDINANCE 2021-1691U AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAL BEACH REPEALING THE EMERGENCY MORATORIUM ON THE EVICTION OF COMMERCIAL TENANTS FOR NON-PAYMENT OF RENT DUE TO COVID-19 FINANCIAL HARDSHIPS AND “NO-FAULT” COMMERCIAL EVICTIONS AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Governor of the State of California (“Governor”) declared a state of emergency to make additional resources available, formalize emergency actions already underway across multiple state agencies and departments, and help the state prepare for the spread of COVID-19; and WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the Governor issued Executive Order N-28-20, which suspended “[a]ny provision of state law that would preempt or otherwise restrict a local government’s exercise of its police power to impose substantive limitations on residential or commercial evictions” of certain tenants affected by the COVID-19 pandemic; and WHEREAS, on April 7, 2020, the City Council adopted emergency regulations (“Urgency Ordinance No. 1683-U”) prohibiting commercial evictions for non-payment of rent and “no-fault” commercial evictions; and WHEREAS, Section 3 of Urgency Ordinance No. 1683-U requires rent to be paid in full by all commercial tenants financially impacted by COVID-19 within six months following the expiration or termination of the local emergency; and WHEREAS, Governor Newsom has repealed his Executive Order providing the authority for cities to adopt commercial eviction moratoria as of September 30, 2021; and WHEREAS, commercial tenants and landlords are encouraged to work together to relieve any further hardships related to COVID-19. NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAL BEACH HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. Findings. The City Council finds that each fact set forth in the preceding recitals is true and correct and incorporated by reference. Section 2. Repeal of Section 3 of Urgency Ordinance No. 1683-U. The City Council hereby repeals Section 3 of Urgency Ordinance No. 1683-U. All other sections of Urgency Ordinance No. 1683-U shall remain in effect. Section 3. Repayment by Commercial Tenants. A commercial tenant that has been unable to pay rent, late fees, or other fees or charges due to financial impacts related to COVID-19 and has otherwise complied with the requirements of Urgency Ordinance No. 1683-U prior to the adoption of this Urgency Ordinance shall have six (6) months following the effective date of this Urgency Ordinance to repay unpaid rent, late fees, or other fees or charges. Section 4. Urgency. The City Council finds that commercial tenants and landlords will likely be confused following September 30, 2021 if the City’s commercial eviction moratorium is not repealed in conjunction with the repeal of the Governor’s Executive Order. The City Council further finds that in order to provide clarity to commercial tenants and decrease the risk of the loss of jobs, local and family-owned businesses, and associated impacts, this Ordinance must be effective immediately. Therefore, the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this Ordinance be enacted as an urgency ordinance pursuant to Government Code section 36937(b) and that it take effect immediately upon adoption pursuant to Government Code section 36934, and its urgency is hereby declared. Section 5. Uncodified. This Ordinance shall not be codified. Section 6. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this Ordinance. Section 7. Effective Date. Based upon the findings in Section 4 of this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by a minimum 4/5 vote of the City Council. Section 8. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and the City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance or a summary thereof to be published as required by law.
